*Oregon. Wild berry flavor with hints of vanilla on the nose. **92 pts Wine Spectator***
- 59 2014 Pinot Noir, Hahn SLH \$48
*California. The nose reveals an inviting combination of deep berry aromas & spicy, toasty oak notes. **Top 100 Wine Spectator***
- 56 2013 Pinot Noir, ZD \$65
Napa, aromas of black cherry, cassis with subtle hints of anise and a slight note of juniper. Sweet, toasty vanilla and spice

Italy. Mouthfilling red fruit, exquisitely balanced cherry and velour tannins.
- 35 2013 Cabernet, Decoy, Sonoma \$49
Velvety tannins, black Currant and spice notes with long finish.
- 39 2014 Barbera d'Alba, Stefano Farina \$41
Piemonte. Aromas of fruits and undertones of vanilla, with flavors of ripe raspberries and blackberries.
- 41 2011 Chianti Classico Riserva, Ruffino \$50
Toscana. An intense, rich bouquet of cherries, tobacco and violets.
- 42 2014 Barbera d'Asti, Vietti \$45
Ruby purple color with ripe red cherry aromas with hints of mineral and vanilla.
- 44 2013 Super Tuscan, Fabio Motta \$48
Tuscany. Fresh fruit corresponding to the nose, balsamical notes. Tannins are present but ripened, rich minerality and balance
- 50 2010 VIno Nobile Riserva, Carpineto \$59
*Toscana. Dry, harmonic and fruity, with an elegant texture and long finish. **93 pts Wine Spectator "Top 100"***
- 51 2013 Super-Tuscan Le Volte, Ornellaia \$56
Toscana. Full-Bodied, velvety with a hint of vanilla, with a long finish.
- 53 2013 Cabernet, Hall, Napa \$68
Layers of blackberry, boysenberry, black currant, dark plums and mocha.
- 75 2013 Nebbiolo, Renato Ratti \$47
Piedmonte. Fine, delicate and persistent bouquet with characteristic trace scents of strawberry and raspberry.

- 32 2013 Primitivo, Rocca di Mori \$45
Full body with soft, round tannins and lots of ripe berry fruit.

*Fresh black licorice and chocolate covered cherries with a nice long finish. **93 pts Wine Spectator***

*A bouquet with traces of licorice and tobacco. Full flavored, full-bodied and elegant **94 pts Wine Spectator***
- 36 2013 Malbec, Catena Classic, Argentina \$45
*Deliciously fruity with rich, chocolate flavors and black pepper. **91 pts Wine Spectator***
- 37 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Mt. Cuvee, Chappellet \$54
Napa Valley. Rich and supple, the mouth feel is seductively soft with no edges.
- 60 2012 Allegrini "Palazzo delle Torre, Veneto \$48
*Deep ruby red with notes of dark, dried cherries, blackberries and hints of dates and mocha **90 pts Wine Spectator***
- 38 2012 Duckhorn Cabernet, Napa \$78
Aromas of Bing cherry and bright raspberry, with flavors of cranberry and anise.
- 40 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon, Ch. Montelena \$95
Napa, juicy red fruit and blueberry, with notes of vanilla and toast.
- 47 2013 Zinfandel, Turley "Pesenti Vineyard" \$89
*Wonderfully fleshy throughout, with plenty of dark red and bluish fruit. Floral and savory notes. **93 pts WS***
- 49 2012 Zinfandel, Seghesio, Sonoma \$48
*Ripe raspberry and blackberry notes, with hints of vanilla, pepper and dried sage. **93 pts WS***

*Toscana. Full-Bodied, dark and powerful with intense aromas of tar. **92 pts Wine Spectator***
